Volunteering has made a world of a difference for Nicholas. "Coming here has opened up another part of my life. It hit me in my heart directly. It's a pleasure to see how people light up so easily just with a simple meal. It just makes me grateful for what I have, and it's a humbling experience," says Nicholas.

"Volunteering here made me realize that I have it a lot better than many," Nicholas shares. "Your money could be stretched out a lot more than a pair of new sneakers. Your money can go a long way here."
