For almost 40 years, St. Thomas has had a sister congregational companionship with the Basotu Lutheran Church in Mbulu, Tanzania.

The original purpose of the mission was to engage in partnerships, cooperating in ministry and mutual programming exchanges in visits, prayers, letters, and education.

When the COVID-19 pandemic hit the United States last spring, our Basotu partners prayed for us, and sought to learn more about our experiences in dealing with the pestilence. Basotu and the Mbulu diocese had their own challenges.

First, horrendous flooding impacted the largely rural and agricultural people, leading to crop failures, food shortages, death, and disease.

Then, COVID hit Tanzania. Only until recently has the national government acknowledged the severity of the pandemic and finally accepted assistance from the outside world.

And, within the last month, due to changing weather patterns Tanzania has experienced the worst outbreak of desert locusts in its modern history – a tragedy of biblical proportions. Hugh swaths of affected areas are being sprayed with pesticides causing panic among residents and farmers

Led by Pastor Elibarki Duwe, our brothers and sisters in Basotu ask us to pray for them, and to remember them in our 40 Days of Generosity during this Lenten season.
