Remember, anything that concerns us, concerns the Lord.

The face of animal rescue has changed throughout the last decade and TAILS wants to be part of that change. We have worked hard over the last two decades to build a premier animal sheltering facility here in Grosse Ile, one that far exceeds the needs of our township. Because one third of TAILS supporters are off-islanders, we would like to be able to help other animals in need with food, supplies or medical care while we continue to identify pet and pet-owner needs here on our own island.

TAILS continues working within our community on programs that will help people keep their pets. We have already identified people here on the island who need help in order to keep their pets. We have an active Kitten Foster Program with about a dozen volunteers caring for and fostering the homeless little one. In 2018, 63 kittens along with several momma cats were in the program; through August 2019, 38 kittens have been helped

Pets are what TAILS started out protecting — we will not abandon them now.
